

Volunteer opportunities are available to help with our Foodbank program. The duties include, set up, distribution to clients, and breakdown. This position is ongoing.

1 person is needed every Thursday 5:00PM -7:30PM for distribution and breakdown. Note: Every third Thursday of the month includes 2:30PM-3:30PM for set up.

<u>During Setup</u>: Volunteers are needed to setup large folding tables and placing steel bins on each table. Volunteers will then need to move large boxes/bags of fresh produce, 30-60 pounds, to these tables. The produce is then placed in large steel bins. All boxes are broken down and taken out for recycling.

<u>During distribution</u>: Volunteers will greet the residents and monitor the amount of food each participant is taking. There are signs on each food item indicating the amount of each item.

<u>During breakdown</u>: Volunteers will assist with breaking down boxes. Taking leftover produce to the garbage and compost. Wiping down all tables and steel bins. Folding up the tables and chairs and some light sweeping.
