PROTECT HUD FUNDING IN CA-02: Ensuring Housing Stability for Our Communities

What is HUD? Vital Programs for CA-02 **The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development** (HUD) provides crucial support through programs like:

- **Housing Choice Vouchers (Section 8):** Helps low-income families afford housing.
- **Continuum of Care (CoC) grants:** Funds homelessness services.
- **HOME & CDBG:** Supports affordable housing and community development.

The Housing Crisis in Numbers

- 4,300+ households depend on vouchers
- Rent ↑ 76% since 2020 | Wages ↑ 22%

The Impossible Housing Gap:

- Marin 2-bed rent: \$3,267/mo → \$62.83/hr needed (3.6× min. wage)
- Humboldt: 85% of extremely low-income spend 50%+ on housing
- Avg. voucher household income: \$22,100/year
- Living wage in Marin (family of 4): \$58,750/adult/year

North Coast Pressures:

- Rural isolation: Limited housing in Trinity, Del Norte & rural Mendocino
- Wildfires: Thousands of homes lost
- Tourism: Vacation rentals reduce local housing stock

Impact on Residents:

- 83% of Marin voucher holders earn <30% AMI
- “Low income” in Marin = \$156,650/year (family of 4)
- 115 Emergency Vouchers for chronically homeless
- HUD-VASH critical for veterans

Wildfire Recovery Needs:

- 5,300+ homes lost in Sonoma fires
- 300+ in Mendocino
- Recovery dependent on federal support (e.g. Santa Rosa, Paradise)

Proposed Cuts Include:

- 40% cut to rental assistance
- Elimination of Section 8 vouchers
- Time limits for able-bodied recipients
- \$700M+ cut to homelessness programs
- Block grants with weaker federal oversight

If Enacted, These Cuts Would:

- Endanger housing for 4,300+ district households
- Jeopardize \$317M+ in wildfire recovery
- Threaten key projects (Golden Gate Village, Point Reyes)
- Increase homelessness among seniors, veterans, and fire survivors
- Undermine future disaster response capacity.
